\*We reserve to raise the event cap after registration if it is deemed feasible for the schedule and event space. There will be a waitlist available for dancers not successful in securing entry and if it is possible to add additional entries, dancers will be pulled from the waitlist.

\*Feis reserves the right to combine competitions as necessary especially with 5 or fewer dancers.

**PRIOR TO REGISTRATION, BE AWARE:**

1. Print and bring your dancer number card. Dancer cards will NOT be available on site.
2. A stage schedule will be posted prior to the feis with arrival times. Please be prepared to abide by these times. There will not be any camping space available on site for dancers and it will be very important to abide by the posted times. Competitors will only be allowed to enter the venue when it is time for their competition and will be expected to leave the venue at the completion of their competition(s). Dancers missing their competition(s) will not be allowed to re-dance. It will be very important for us to remain on schedule to keep the days flowing properly.
3. **ONLY ONE SUPPORT PERSON PER DANCER** will be allowed IN the dancing areas with the dancer during their assigned dance time. This will be monitored at the doors and **NO** exceptions will be allowed. **NO ADDITIONAL ATTENDEES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE BUILDING** (this rule also applies to additional children or dancers from the family). If you have multiple dancers, we must request that you please make arrangements for them while they are not dancing if need be as we cannot allow additional people in the building in order to abide by state mandated occupancy regulations at this time.
4. Results will be posted on our social media. We are working on the best plan for distribution of awards and more details on this will be posted at a later date.
5. Masks that cover the nose and mouth are **REQUIRED** by all attendees **AT ALL TIMES**.
6. Dancers will be able to remove their masks while dancing. Please bring a bag for dancers to place their mask in before stepping on stage.
7. As events in our region have been filling and capping very quickly, payment of entries is expected promptly upon entry in order to give everyone a fair chance to enter. Entries which are not paid promptly may be deleted to allow others the chance to enter.
8. Friday competitions will begin no earlier than 5pm. More details will be released closer to the date of the event.
